The Life Center (TLC), Heartland Counseling Services' day rehab center providing support for Siouxland adults facing severe persistent mental health and substance abuse challenges, proudly announces the successful completion of a transformative project aimed at enhancing emergency response capabilities and member safety. This initiative was made possible through the generous support of a grant from the United Airlines Trust Fund, contributing to the acquisition of a state-of-the-art Automated External Defibrillator (AED) and comprehensive staff training.

Since Heartland's move to 1201 Arbor Drive in South Sioux City, safety measures across the organization have undergone thorough review and updates, aligning with the commitment to the well-being of its members, including those at The Life Center. The transformative project focused on enhancing emergency response capabilities, with the acquisition of the AED playing a central role in fostering a safer environment for all TLC members. The grant from the United Airlines Trust Fund also facilitated extensive training for community-based staff, empowering them with the skills and confidence needed to address potential cardiac incidents effectively.
